CIRCULAR 36 of ASA 2021 – ASA CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS (17 – 18 SEPTEMBER, AMANZIMTOTI, KWAZULU-NATAL)

Due to the instability of the pandemic and growing new variants, likewise, decisions on competitions are reviewed and adjusted constantly to match the health risks and advice of the time.

This uncertainty in the performance of the virus has affected many of us, including ASA member provinces, athletes, coaches and parents who had made their private pre-bookings of flights, accommodation and other.

ASA is therefore pleased to inform you that age categories 8 – 13 will now be allowed to participate in the 2021 ASA Cross Country Championships.

ASA has tried its best to accommodate as many age groups as possible, but unfortunately could not satisfy all ages which are 50 and above.

The 2021 ASA Cross Country Championships will now be a two day event from 17 – 18 September 2021. Age categories 8 – 13 years will participate on Friday, 17 September 2021 and age categories 14 – 49 years will continue to participate as per Circular 35 of ASA 2021 on Saturday, 18 September 2021.

More information regarding day one for age categories 8 – 13 years will follow in due course.
